

HABC Level 2 Certificate in Introduction to Autistic Spectrum Conditions (RQF*)

Overview:

This care training course is aimed at care workers who work with service users who have Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD), including Asperger's.

Candidates will gain a better understanding of what ASD is and the effects it has on an individual, allowing them to better support people with a variety of needs.

Learning Outcomes:

The training allows the learner to:

- Understand autism, its related conditions, and underpinning theories
- Understand how autism is diagnosed
- Understand how autism affects individuals
- Understand the person-centred approach with individuals who have autistic spectrum conditions
- Understand how to support individuals and their carers to manage behaviours
- Understand how to support individuals with autism during transitions
- Understand how to support individuals with autism to maintain personal safety and engage in positive risk-taking
- Understand how to support individuals with autism to access services and opportunities
- Understand speech and language development in individuals who have autistic spectrum conditions
- Understand how to support communication and social interaction with individuals who have autistic spectrum conditions
- Understand the differences in sensory processing, cognition and awareness of individuals with autistic spectrum conditions.

Delivery Method

1. Three live Zoom group seminars with tutor spread over three weeks, supplemented by tutor led support through to completion of qualifying electronic workbook.
2. Additional videos and learner resources available and used to help focus learning.
3. Case studies and quizzes to help embed the learning into real-life situations.
4. Virtual breakout rooms for smaller group discussion and exercises.
5. Each Zoom session lasts approximately 2 hrs.



PLEASE NOTE: As this is comprehensive and in-depth course, learners will need to complete a short diagnostic of their written English skills before joining a group.

All learners will need to have access to a Laptop/PC/Tablet and have internet access. Workbooks will be able to be completed electronically (via Word or Editable PDF).

Fee - Fully funded through Skills for Care's Workforce Development Fund. To be eligible for funding employers will need to engage with the ASC Workforce Data Set (previously known as the NMDS-SC) and join a local employer partnership.
